A Tillamook Bay Fire & Rescue Rural Fire Protection District would unify the Tillamook Fire District and Bay City Fire Department. The new district would operate under the direction of a newly, elected board of directors.



A NEW DISTRICT!

Each former fire organization would dissolve and create one district that would serve approximately 18,385 permanent residents in the Tillamook and Bay City areas.

BACKED BY CITY COUNCILS! A resolution to support a petition and place the measure on the May ballot was unanimously approved by the Bay City Council and Tillamook City Council.

BALLOT MEASURE! Voters will decide about the unification on the May 2026 ballot.



MILLIONS OF SUPPORT! A unified tax rate of \$1.49 per \$1,000 assessed property value could generate \$2.46 million annually for district operations.
